

And in the process, I pledge to make happiness my moral companion As I travel this life leaving it better than before I happened upon it.





OUR FOUNDERS: OUR INSPIRATION

Don Bosco: Our Founder

Johnny Bosco, a shepherd boy, was born on August 16, 1815, in Becchi, Italy. He lost his father at the age of two. The grief-stricken words of his mother, telling him that he was now fatherless remained deeply impressed in the child's mind, and perhaps helped to instill into his mind the intense empathy for the orphans and the homeless

which became the dominant note of his life.

At the age of nine, little Johnny Bosco was given a mission in a vision. He was to transform wolves into lambs "NOT WITH BLOWS BUT WITH KINDNESS" that was the method he was given. Overcoming untold hardship and hostility he became a priest on June 5, 1841. His determination to be a Priest for YOUTH combined with his dynamic optimism gradually resulted in the flowering of his long cherished dream. Don Bosco saw the untold misery of the poor boys of the working class at Turin. He saw them and other youth like them, understood their situation to the fullest extent and determined to conquer them with Reason, Religion and Loving Kindness. He opened his little house in 1846. Blooming in spite of its poverty, it soon grew into a boarding School, youth centre and a professional school.

Don Bosco was one of the greatest educators the world has ever produced. He loved the young people passionately and dedicated his entire life to make them live a dignified life. He was a man with a great dream and vision, undaunted courage and visionary foresight. He is a great Founder who founded a great society with three main branches: Salesian Fathers and Brothers (SDB), Salesian Sisters (FMA) and the Association of Salesian Cooperators (ASC). Millions are now students and Past Pupils, all over the world. They are proud of their education and the values they have received in the school. So many have excelled in life and occupy a great place of responsibility in the society and have contributed to make this world a better place.

In another vision the Virgin Mary pointing to a group of girls said to him: "Take care of them, they too are my children". This came as a heavenly confirmation to a cherished dream of his to extend his work also in favour of girls.

The work of this humble priest has grown from a tiny seed on to a gigantic tree. He lived to be 73. Not a great age; but his work was done. He died in the morning of 31st January 1888. Don Bosco was declared a Saint of the Catholic Church on 1st April 1934. Pope John Paul II on the occasion of the Centenary of his death in 1988 declared him as the Father and Teacher of all young people.

ST. MARY MAZZARELLO: OUR CO-FOUNDRESS

God's ways are marvelous. Contemporaneously with Don Bosco, Mary Mazzarello in a little village of Mornese, thirsted with the same desire to help children and young girls.

She too did receive a heavenly mandate. While

walking down the uninhabited slopes of Borgo Alto she saw a group of girls playing in the non-existent playground and a strong voice firm and steady gave her a legacy "I entrust them to you." Was it a dream, a hallucination? Yet there she was fully awake, walking in full consciousness.

In 1864 came the momentous meeting with Don Bosco. "He is a saint! I can feel it!" she said to all. Don Bosco too saw something equally precious in her. In Mary Mazzarello a likeminded soul, Salesian by instinct, Don Bosco found a ready, active, receptive and creative collaborator.

In a society, which basically ignored the potential and rights of peasant women, Mary Mazzarello and the early Salesian Sisters understood that education was the key to their empowerment. In creative fidelity they incarnated Don Bosco's Preventive System in the world of women.

August 5, 1872 saw the foundation of another new branch of Don Bosco's family: the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of

Christians (FMA), familiarly known as Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco, with Mary Mazzarello as their leader. Imbued with the spirit of Don Bosco, Mary Mazzarello and the first Sisters, marched forward in the quest of providing integral formation for girls. In 1875 saw the expansion of the Salesian work outside Europe. In 1922 India welcomed the Salesian Sisters. Today, Don Bosco's unique charism for young people lives on - ever alive and ever relevant to the signs of the time, in different parts of the world where Salesian presence is felt and touched through his Sons and Daughters.

As the feminine branch of the Salesian Family, Mary Mazzarello sought to do for girls what Don Bosco was doing for boys - that particular feminine genius which blends itself so well to nurturing, teaching and encouraging the young girls along the way of Integral growth and development.

Mary Mazzarello died on May 14, 1881 in Nizza Monferrato, Italy. She was beatified on November 20, 1938 and canonized on June 24, 1951.

Today Don Bosco's unique Charism for youth lives on undiminished in its original freshness and dynamism in every corner of the earth. Don Bosco International educates over 15 million students in the world. Where youth exists there Don Bosco is present through his Sons and Daughters for whom Don Bosco is a never tiring Father, Teacher, Founder, Friend and Leader, ever relevant for Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow.

Watch your thoughts; they lead to attitudes. Watch your attitudes; they lead to words. Watch your words; they lead to actions. Watch your actions; they lead to habits. Watch your habits; they form your character. Watch your Character; it determines your destiny.

AUXILIUM GIRLS' SCHOOL - AGARTALA

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Auxilium Girls' School - a Catholic minority educational institution is situated in the suburbs of Nandan Nagar, 3 kms away from the Agartala town. It is the first Girls' English Medium School in the State of Tripura. The School was established in 2003 and is catering to girls irrespective of caste and creed. The School is recognized by the Govt. of Tripura. Affiliation to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE Affiliation No 2030012, School Code: 35385), New Delhi in 2009, upgradation to Senior Secondary in 2013 and modernization of infrastructure in keeping with the requirements of the times have opened new windows of opportunities and challenges in all fields of education, making Auxilium one of the Premier educational institutions in the State of Tripura.

2. OWNERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

The School is owned and administered by the Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco (FMA) of Shillong Province, registered as "Auxilium Welfare Society' under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and has its Provincial Headquarters at Auxilium - Nongthymmai, Shillong.

The Institute of the Salesian Sisters is an organization founded in Italy in the year 1872 by Don Bosco, the great modern educator in collaboration with St. Mary Domenica Mazzarello. The International Headquarters is located in Rome (Italy). They are a worldwide organization that takes care of the young people giving great importance to their all-round growth and development through integral education. Today, the spiritual children of Don Bosco, (Salesian Fathers, Salesian Sisters and Salesian Cooperators and other members of the Salesian Family) continue the rich legacy he had bequeathed to them, bringing hope and love to the lives of millions of young people and lead them to the horizons far beyond their reach. We, the Salesian Sisters numbering about 12,000 work in the Spirit of Don Bosco and St. Mary Mazzarello through more than 1500 educational institutions spread over 94 different countries on all six continents.

3. OUR INSPIRATION

As a Christian minority educational institution, the Lord Jesus is our Teacher, our Source of inspiration, motivation and strength. His unconditional love, optimism and joy, his compassion for the weak and the vulnerable and his forgiving love for all and commitment to universal brotherhood and sisterhood inspires and guides all our educational ventures.

4. OUR VISION AND MISSION

The aim of the school is to ensure the integral formation of the students, striving to form them into good human beings, upright and honest citizens of our nation and to bring out those qualities which are best and noblest in them. Special attention is given to ensure high standard of morality and discipline in the school.

The school takes great care to enable the students to become Physically Fit, Intellectually Competent, Morally Upright, Spiritually Inspired and Socially Committed persons at the service of the nation and the world of today and tomorrow by imparting holistic and personalized education. Being a school only for girls, special care is taken to educate girls to values and virtues, to accept and love their femininity and stand against those forces that hinder their equality.

5. MOTTO

The Motto of the school is 'VIRTUE AND KNOWLEDGE'. The school aims to form students in virtue and impart knowledge and skills required to face life with all its challenges.

6. THE EDUCATIONAL APPROACH

The Educational Philosophy followed in the school is called the **Preventive System of Don Bosco**, one of the greatest modern Educators of the 19th century. His system of education was simple, functional and person centered, based on the three great principles of **Reason, Religion and Rapport**. Don Bosco tried to draw forth the best in a child and ensured the child's complete self-expression. His system of education, popularly called the "the Preventive System", consists in:

- ❖ Rooting out evil with the Warm and Caring, Friendly and Active, Loving and Listening and Accompanying Presence of the Educators among the students.
- ❖ An educative style of relationship founded on Reason, Religion and Loving-kindness within a family-like atmosphere of joy and happiness, spontaneity and cheerfulness.
- ❖ A spirit of enquiry and insatiable quest for **Knowledge and** acquisition of Virtue as indicated in the Motto of the school.
- ❖ An ambience of Responsible Freedom and Autonomy.

The Management, Staff and Students, Parents and Guardians constitute an integral unit known as the Educating Community whose primary aim is to form young people to become builders of an honest society, women of upright thinking and acting, commitment and competence imbued with Sound Knowledge, Values and Virtues.

7. CURRICULUM

- 1. The school has classes from Nursery to Class XII (2022-23)
- 2. The School prepares the students for All India Secondary School Examination (X) and All India Senior Secondary School Examination (XII) conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi.
- 3. Auxilium Girls' School is an English Medium School. Every effort is made to teach the students to handle English effectively as a written and spoken language. To acquire greater facility in the study of English, teachers and students should speak only in English in the School premises.
- 4. The other languages taught are Hindi, Bengali and Sanskrit.
- 5. The classes of Christian Doctrine are an essential feature of the training of Christian Students and for others lessons in Value Education are held regularly and these classes are compulsory.
- 6. In order to develop the students' personality, talents, initiative and originality, scope and facilities are given for various coscholastic activities and Student Development Programmes which are conducted on a regular basis.

8. ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

- 1. Admission is granted at class Nursery to children who have completed three years of age on 1st of April. Forms will be made available in the last week of October.
- 2. Admission to other classes will depend on the availability of seats. Information will be given in the first week of March.
- 3. At the time of admission, the Original Birth Certificate along with the photocopy should be produced. Parents/Guardians are asked to fill the Admission form with the utmost accuracy. No subsequent changes will be permitted. The name and the date of birth once registered will not be altered.
- 4. New students must be introduced personally to the Principal by their parents or guardians who will be responsible for their regularity, conduct and fees.
- 5. The School Leaving certificate can be collected from the school office after two working days of the submission of the application, mentioning the Admission number, class, section and Roll No of the student (Sample copy is available at the back pages)
- 6. Transfer Certificate from a school outside Tripura must be countersigned by the Education Officer of the District concerned.
- 7. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, immorality, insubordination, bad conduct or sickness liable to be injurious to other students, contempt of authority, disrespect towards the staff, willful damage of property, justify dismissal. The Principal's decision is final in all cases of dismissal or withdrawal.
- 8. Only unmarried girls are given admission in the school.

9. SCHOOL FEES

 The School fees cover twelve calendar months and are paid in six installments or in advance. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods. Pupils are charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls. Fees once paid are not refunded.

- 2. **For any** Information with regards to all fees, please refer to the Fee Book.
- 3. Fees for classes Nursery to Class V will be received by the South Indian Bank (SIB), Classes VI to XII by the Federal Bank, on behalf of the Institution and shall be paid on or before 15th of April, June, August, October December, February; failing which a fine of Rs.50/- per month will be levied on all late payments.
- 4. Students joining or leaving the school during any term will have to pay all the fees of that term and the annual fee (Terms: April-May, June-July, Aug-Sept, Oct- Nov, Dec-Jan, Feb- March)
- 5. No bills or reminders are issued: therefore, parents/guardians should see that the fees are paid on time
- 6. Those who have not paid the school fees may not be allowed to sit for the Half Yearly and Final Examinations, unless parents contact the office and give an written application.
- 7. Any certificate or extract from the register will cost Rs.100/-
- 8. A duplicate Fee Book can be obtained on payment of Rs. 100/-
- 9. The School reserves the right to increase the fees at any time of the year if an increment is considered necessary. **Ten percent annual increase in the fees is normal.**
- 10. Fees once paid are not refunded.

10. ASSESSMENTS & PROMOTION

- CBSE has introduced new assessment structure for all classes.
 For the purpose of gradual learning, two tests will be held-two unit tests one in **June-July** and another one in **December**,
 Half yearly Examination will be in **September** and Final
 Examinations in **February-March**, with portions of syllabus
 cumulatively covered. The gradual increasing portion of
 contents would prepare students acquire confidence for the
 appearing the Board examination with 100% syllabus.
 - Unit Test 1 & 11 will be of 50 marks (15 oral and 35 written)

- Half Yearly Examination will be of 80 marks written, 10 marks from Unit Test 1, 5 marks for notebooks submission and 5 marks for subject enrichment activity.
- Final Examination: 80 marks from the syllabus; 10 from the periodic test (average of the best two tests), 5 marks for notebook submission and 5 marks for subject enrichment activity.
- 2. Notebook submission as a part of internal assessment is aimed at enhancing seriousness of students towards preparing notes for the topics being taught in the classroom as well as assignments, They also address the critical aspect of regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep. Students who maintain well and submit regularly for checking will receive a certificate of merit at the end of the year.
- 3. Subject Enrichment Activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. For Languages effective speaking and listening skills; for Mathematics Lab activities; for Science practical works/activities and for social Science Map and Project work and other creative projects and assignments. Auxi_Ignite our school exhibition will be a great occasion to think and imagine, create and invent various projects and assignments.
- 4. To secure promotion one must obtain 40% of marks in all the subjects. The promotion of a student to the higher class implies that the student has successfully learned a prescribed syllabus. To be promoted, the student must know well, the subject matter.
- 5. School gives utmost importance to character, integrity and ethics and teaches the students to live by it in their day to day life, especially during the examinations.
- 6. Any student found resorting to unfair means in any examination will be given zero in the subject and will not be allowed to write the rest of the papers in that examination. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal. Any student who is found tampering with marks in the Progress Report and other school certificates will be asked to leave the school.

- 7. Re-exams/Tests are not held for absent students. If a student is prevented by illness her promotion will be decided according to her performance during the year.
- 8. Those who do not do home works, or bring text/exercise books etc. 2 marks will be deducted from the ensuing exams.
- 9. Due to any unforeseen circumstances, if a test/exam is not held on the scheduled date, the same will be held on the next working day unless otherwise notified.
- 10. Promotion is decided at the staff meeting. Hence, results are final and cannot be reconsidered. Answer Scripts of all the tests (Unit Tests, Half yearly Examinations) will be shown to the parents as given in the School Diary and the parents can retain them, while the Final Examinations Answer Scripts will be shown to the parents and they are retained in the school.

11.LEAVE AND ABSENCE

- 1. Admission in Auxilium Girls' School implies on the part of the pupils and parents, willingness to comply with the requirements and regulations of the school.
- 2. Staying away from school without authorization is not permitted except when the cause is sudden illness or other unforeseen circumstances.
- 3. Vacation: (Check the Holiday List). These holidays may not be extended or anticipated.
- 4. It is compulsory to attend the classes on the last working day before the start of the vacation and also on the opening day after the vacation. Those absent on the re-opening day after vacation (except those with prior written permission) must be accompanied by their parents to school on the joining day. A fine of Rs 50/- per absent calendar day is levied on all the defaulters.
- 5. No student will be allowed to leave the School premises during School hours except on the strength of a letter of request from the parent/guardian duly signed, and sanctioned by the Principal. During the school hours, students will be allowed to go only with their parents.

- 6. Students, who have been absent from class must have the reason for their absence briefly noted in their "Regularity Record" in the Diary signed by their parents, and counter signed by the Principal or the Sister-in-Charge before entering in the class. Reasons of a private nature may be intimated by letter. Birthdays, excursions, festivals, social functions, family affairs, urgent business are not sufficient reasons for leave. Absence from School in order to study is not allowed. Absence from school without prior leave is not tolerated except when the cause is sudden illness or unforeseen circumstances.
- 7. Absentees at an examination will be considered as having failed unless it is established that their absence was due to illness. Absence before the examination will not be tolerated.
- 8. If absence on account of illness lasts for three days and more the application for leave must be made to the Principal, accompanied by Doctor's certificate.
- 9. Late arrival to school is a breach of discipline. A student who comes late to school must enter the date and time of arrival in the "Regularity Record" under 'Late'. Admission to class for absentees and late comers is granted when they show the teacher-in-charge the Regularity record duly countersigned by the Principal or sister-in-charge.
- 10. No pupil will be allowed to sit for the last term examination if the attendance during the year is below 85%.
- 11. Students having 100% attendance will receive a merit certificate.

12. SCHOOL UNIFORMS

1. It is strictly necessary for every student to come to school with full uniform including footwear:

ALL THROUGH THE YEAR:

- a. Pinafores, pink shirts with stiff collar, short sleeves with pocket monogram (Class Nursery to class II)
- b. Pleated skirts, pink shirts (one inch above the knee), stiff collar with short sleeves and pocket monogram (Class III X)

c. Grey trousers and pink shirts (Class XI & XII)

Black shoes (naughty boys), white socks with blue strips, white ribbon and white hair band, School Belt and Tie for all

DURING WINTER:

- a. Grey pinafores, pink shirts with stiff collar, long sleeves with pocket monogram (Class Nursery to class II)
- b. Grey pleated skirts, pink shirts, stiff collar with long sleeves and pocket monogram (Class III X)
- c. Grey school sweater (till class IV) /Blazer (Class V XII)

On Wednesdays: House Uniform

- a. House T. Shirt & Track Suit (Class I -XII)
- b. White Canvas

On Saturdays: Club Uniform

c. Special Uniform according to the Clubs the student belong. For hikes, Picnics, P.T and Sports Days and on all Wednesdays white Canvas.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Every student should wear a clean, complete and proper uniform daily. Any pupil without proper uniform or whose uniform is untidy or ill-fitting will not be allowed to attend classes.
- 2. Students should have sufficient sets of uniform and they are to be stitched from the tailors authorized by the school only who have been instructed regarding the style and stitching.
- 3. All students must use white hair bands and tie their hair neatly with white ribbon. Mehendi, Kajal, bindi, nail polish, perfumes, bangles and tabis (visible) are not allowed as well as ornaments and jewellery of any kind are not allowed in the school

13. CO-CORRICULAR ACTIVITIES - WINDOWS OF OPPORTUNITY

Though academic excellence is aimed at by the school, education being the all round development of the innate talents of a child, the school provides many possibilities for every student to participate in a variety of co-curricular and extra - curricular

activities on a regular basis, so that, they can grow into multifaceted personalities, which is a need of the hour. The concept of testing the multiple intelligence of children, makes every student feel like a winner. By providing a number of co-curricular activities, we ensure the expression of potential capacities of each student, like drawing and painting, creative writing and public speaking, essay writing and debate, singing and music, dance and dramatics, team building and capacity to organize programmes and functions etc. which provide training in different aspects of personality development of students.

School promotes various Clubs, such as - Singing Club, Dance Club, Eco Peace and Disaster Management Club, Literary Club, Guitar Club, Science Club, Media Club, Maths Club, Fine Arts Club, Yoga Club, Karate Club, NCC, Girl Guides, Legal Education Club, Stitching, Knitting and Embroidery Club etc. as well as the, Annual Picnic, Annual Sports, Annual School Exhibition (AUXI IGNITE) and Annual Day Celebrations, as well as various International Olympiads encourage children to take up various learning based activities in the true spirit of healthy competition and collaboration. All these activities are meant to develop the total personality of students. School organizes regular programmes and the parents and guardians should encourage their children to participate in them whole heartedly. These activities nurture interests, promote aptitude, strengthen abilities of students and sometimes act as a determining factor for the choice of future vocation. Some co-curricular activities are conducted class-wise and others based on the House System. There are four Houses each having its own Colour, Patron and Motto. They are guided by the House Moderators. Each House is headed by a General House Captain, Vice Captain and other House Captains from each class

The House system aims at fostering a spirit of co-operation, unity and healthy competition for the integral growth of the students.

14. LIBRARY

- 1. The school provides excellent Library facilities with a spacious reading room and a Reference Library, for senior students. Besides every class from III onwards has a class room library with about 200 books. Students are encouraged and exhorted to cultivate the reading habit. To promote the habit of reading good books, those who read most books in the academic session are awarded with a special **Merit Certificate and a Trophy.**
- 2. Books lost or damaged must be made good by the student.
- 3. Absolute silence is to be maintained in the library.
- 4. No books, papers or bags of any kind and water bottles are to be brought into the library except a pen and a Hand Diary
- 5. Students resorting to any damage to the Library books, furniture, fittings, etc., scribbling on the walls, floors and extraction of pages from any book whatsoever, will have to make good such a damage and will be debarred permanently from access to the library.
- 6. Students are not permitted in the Library except during the stipulated period. Exceptions need special permission.
- 7. Students should enter and leave the library premises in orderly and disciplined manner.
- 8. Students are expected to keep the books in order after reading. When taking a book, if any defect is noticed, it should be brought to the notice of the Librarian.

15. TRANSPORTATION

School Provides Transport Services and they are available for transporting the students. Those who wish to avail school transport services may apply for the same during the time of admission. The school provides transport facilities but offers no guarantee that a seat in the school bus is available, when the

vehicles are too full to capacity or do not ply in the area of the residence of the students. The school hires the buses and pays the bus owners a fixed charge, every month for the whole year. Discontinuing the bus facility in the middle of the year has financial implications. And once a students' seat in the school bus is confirmed, she will not be permitted to cancel the seat in the middle of the year (except on transfer cases) and in case of cancellation she is required to pay for the whole year.

- Students who avail the school bus service should report to the assigned pick-up point at least five minutes before the stipulated time.
- 2. A student will not be permitted to ride a bus other than the one to which she is assigned
- 3. Students will board the buses in an orderly manner, giving due priority to younger students.
- 4. Any request to change the bus must be submitted to the Principal prior to the change that is to be made. Bus captain shall be assigned to help maintain discipline.
- 5. The following acts are considered serious violations:
 - a) Discourtesy and disobedience to the driver or conductor
 - b) Changing places frequently while the bus is in motion
 - c) Discourtesy to other children
 - d) Pushing and jostling when boarding the bus
 - e) Trying to distract the bus driver's attention
 - f) Destroying bus property.

Payment for damage will be required before the offender is reinstated on the bus.

- 6. In the event, a child is involved in a discipline problem while riding a bus, the principal, at her discretion, may take any disciplinary action, even suspending the offender from bus.
- 7. The school is not responsible for any student who boards a wrong bus from school by intent or goes to another student's house without explicit information from the parent verified by the school authority.

8. Though every care will be taken for the safety of students, the school will not be held responsible for any damage, injury/loss of life and /or property due to any accident and/or otherwise failure to pick up or reach the students on time.

For those who use other than School Transport

9. Parents having some transport arrangement must report to school before the Morning Assembly and take the children after the school ends. No cars or any other transport mode will be permitted to be parked in the school campus

16. GENERAL RULES

- 1. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belongings. Money should not be lent or borrowed or articles exchanged. The school is not responsible for the loss of goods or money.
- 2. Daily requirements and tiffin have to be brought to the school by the students. No items will be accepted at the school counter or gate.
- 3. Care must be taken of the school property. The students must not write, scratch or spoil the furniture, or in any way damage what is provided for their use. Any damage done to the school property must be made good by the student concerned.
- 4. Electronic goods (mobile phones, cameras, CDs, Pen-drives, Tabs, Laptops etc.) expensive pens/watches, jewellery, cash or toys etc. is strictly prohibited within the school. If any of these items are found in the possession of students, they will be confiscated and will not be returned.
- 5. Parents and pupils (individually or collectively) are forbidden to give gifts to the teachers.
- 6. Students are forbidden to give birthday gifts to one another. A token gift of chocolate may be allowed.
- 7. Collection for any purpose whatsoever requires the Principal's sanction.
- 8. Students should not bring more than Rs 30/- for the purpose of snacks to the school.

- 9. Students are forbidden to bring crackers, explosives and other dangerous materials to school.
- 10. Every precaution is taken to avoid accidents. If any accident occurs in school first aid will be given. However, when hospitalization is necessary it may be done even before the parents/guardians can be informed. Ordinarily the students will be sent to the hospital nearest to the school. Hospital expenses must be borne by the parent/guardian.
- 11. Students are not allowed to enter class rooms other than their own.
- 12. In the absence of the Teacher in the class-room, students are required to observe silence and obey the class Monitor.
- 13. Staying away from mandatory school function, including Annual Day and Sports Day without prior permission or justification will be considered a major discipline default.
- 14. Students are responsible to school authorities for their conduct not only in the school but also for their general behavior outside. Any report or observed objectionable conduct outside the school on the part of the pupils will make them liable to disciplinary action. It is expected that through their good behavior they must enhance the prestige of the school.
- 15. Although the conservation of our environment is fundamental, it is also equally decent that applications made to the Principal or the School Office be done in a decent sheet of paper. Applications submitted to the office or to the Principal inappropriately will not be considered.
- 16. School diary is to be preserved carefully and no page from it should be destroyed or smudged. Anyone losing it should get a written authorization from the Principal to buy duplicate with a fine of Rs.200/-
- 17. After School hours, students are not permitted to go from school for group outings organized on their own or on their friends' houses for birthday parties or any other celebrations.

17. FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. The support and collaboration of parents/guardians in all

- cases is considered indispensable to the success of the work of education carried out by the School.
- 2. Ordinarily communications with parents/guardians are made through the School Diary. Parents/guardians are requested to go through the School Diary daily and to sign the remarks/comments made by the Principal / Sister-in-charge or teachers.
- 3. All communications to the School should be addressed to the Principal.
- 4. Periodic reports and the Report Cards will keep parents/ guardians informed of the progress of their wards. These reports are to be checked and signed by the parents and maintained carefully.
- 5. As a principle Private Tuitions are discouraged. If private tuitions are taken from the Class Teacher the Principal must be informed
- 6. Parents/guardians are requested to co-operate with the School authorities:
 - ❖ By urging their children to be regular and punctual in attendance.
 - By encouraging them to participate in activities conducted by the school
 - By seeing that they are diligent at the homework and lessons
 - By insisting on neatness and cleanliness in the text books, note books and personal appearance of their wards.
 - By occasionally seeking an interview with the Principal and the teacher concerned to discuss the progress of their wards.
- 7. In the CampusCare, all records, contact Number, address of parents/guardians is maintained, which helps us to contact you immediately or to send SMS at any time. Any change of address as well as Contact Number should be communicated to the School office without delay, failing which the school will not be responsible for non-receipt of communication.

8. At all times speak well of the school, teachers and administration, especially in the presence of your children. Should you have any legitimate grievance, meet the Principal at the earliest. If you still feel that the method and education that is imparted, the fee that is being charged, the discipline that is enforced or the ambience in the school is not up to your expectation and satisfaction, please feel free to withdraw your child from the school at any time.

18. PARENTS-TEACHERS INTERACTIVE MEET

- 1. A regular Parent-Teacher interaction is very important for the all round development and formation of the student.
- 2. Parents are welcome to visit the school. However parents or guardians are not allowed to see their children or interview teachers during School hours without the permission of the Principal. They are free to meet any teacher taking a prior appointment with the teacher concerned through the communication page in the school diary, between 9.55-10.20 am. (Nursery to class II) and 10.30 am to 10.50 am for class III to class XII.
- 3. The annual Parent-Teacher Interactive meet and the Open Days as given in the School Diary is of utmost importance and compulsory. It will help the parents to own responsibility as partners for the integral formation of the students, in the educational process.

19. SUGGESTIONS FOR STUDY AT HOME

To avoid heavy load of work at the time of examination for their child parents are requested:

To provide a fairly convenient place for their daughter's study at home. Provide a desk and a chair, away from all noise, TV, smart phone etc. Studying on the bed is to be discouraged.
Make a personal study time-table for her and see that she works at it with sufficient time.
Remember if you give your time and supervise your child's daily lessons, private tuitions are not required.

20. GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- Read the school diary carefully and bring it to school every day. Make a note in it of anything important to you.
- AUXILIUM is your School. Keep it clean and tidy so that you and others may be proud of your School.
- Converse in English. Encourage your friends to do the same.
- ♦ Aim at 100% attendance and unfailing punctuality.
- Inculcate good values and imbibe good qualities of honesty and sincerity.
- Work hard and do well in every field. Your parents, school, society and nation expect a lot from you.
- Do not leave the classroom or school compound without prior permission.
- Always behave in such a way, that your parents and teachers feel proud of you.
- ❖ Take care of the school property. This is your second home.
- Read good books. They are a source of knowledge and your true companions.
- Be a person with good character and cultivate good manners. You will earn the respect of others.
- ❖ Be systematic and well organized in everything you do.
- Make a personal time-table, allotting time for study, play, entertainment etc.
- Read the newspapers daily. It will help you to be aware of current affair which is very much needed in this highly competitive world of today.
- Never give up till you succeed. Remember you are meant to be a winner. Untiring effort, consistent Hard Work is the need of the hour.
- Each one of us has been created for a definite purpose. So identify your talent/interest in any field and develop it responsibly.

21.ATTITUDE TO TEACHERS

- Respect every teacher. Be grateful towards those who taught in the past. Show your teachers those exterior signs of reverence due to them, such as greeting them whenever and wherever you meet them.
- 2. Be convinced that your teachers deeply feel their serious obligation of promoting your welfare in the best way they possibly can, and that in advising, accompanying and correcting you, they have nothing else in view than your own good.
- 3. Your first duty as a student, consists in doing the tasks assigned to you by your teachers.
- 4. Always rise when your teachers enter and leave the class. If she/he delays in coming, do not make noise, but wait for him/her in your place in silence, reviewing your lesson.
- 5. During class avoid whispering or interrupting.

22. ATTITUDE TO SCHOOL-MATES

- 1. Strive and edify your school-mates by your good example at all times. In fact no sermon is more efficacious than good example.
- 2. Respect and be more considerate of those who look different from you, those who are slow learners etc. Let there be no ridiculing of anyone on account of her physical defects. What you laugh at or despise in others may some day befall you.
- 3. Gladly help one another. At break time make no distinction in the choice of your companion. Let no one be slighted in any game and let there be no selfishness. If there be need to make sacrifice for the sake of the Team let it be made cheerfully.
- 4. When you are asked by the authority regarding the conduct of your companion, answer to the best of your knowledge especially when it is the matter of remedying some evil. To be silent would not be beneficial to your companion and would be offensive to God. Always avoid exaggerations and speak truthfully.

23. BEHAVIOUR AT SCHOOL

- 1. To write or draw on the blackboard (Except when called upon to do so by your teachers), to write words offensive to anyone, to soil walls, boards or anything else are habits absolutely to be avoided.
- 2. Take great care of your Text books, Note books and other belongings. Beware of appropriating your neighbour's property even if it be the smallest thing. Should you find a lost article give at once to the sister-in-charge
- 3. Keep the floor clean by allowing no paper or ink to fall on it. Cleanliness and purity of soul are reflected by a clean and neat exterior.
- 4. Remember always to speak well of your school, your school-mates, teachers and the management.

24. RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLASS CAPTAINS/VICE CAPTAINS

- 1. Special attention shall be paid by the Class Teachers in choosing suitable leaders. Names to be submitted to the supervisors whenever there is a change.
- 2. The Captains must be as far as possible exemplary in conduct and diligent in their studies & regularly come to school.
- 3. They must be able to command respect in the class
- 4. Their assistance and active involvement is required for all the day-to-day activities: maintaining discipline, attending to the cleanliness and the neatness of the classroom, informing to the concerned authorities about various needs of the class, up-keeping the bulletin boards etc.
- 5. They must rub out the writing on the green board immediately after each class.
- 6. The leader will write each day on the green board, the date and the number of the students present out of the total in their class.
- 7. The leaders will be responsible for all the happening in the class during the absence of the teacher.
- 8. Once a month a meeting of the leaders will be held under

- the guidance of the supervisors when the methods and the means are discussed and adopted for improving discipline and redressing grievances.
- 9. It is the duty of all the leaders to report to the Principal, the Sister-in-charge or the class Teacher any breach of discipline noticed even during the recess.
- 10. In the event of a teacher being absent, they must inform the Principal, Vice Principal within the first five minutes from the commencement of the periods.

25. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HEAD GIRL, ASST. HEAD GIRL, SCHOOL CAPTAIN AND SCHOOL VICE CAPTAINS

- 1. They should ensure that the leaders carry out their duties in a responsible and impartial manner.
- They should command the whole school in discipline at prayers, assemblies every morning and at all school gatherings.
- 3. They should be constantly alert, observant and sensitive to the needs of the school and act promptly after consulting and getting orders from the Principal/Vice Principal
- 4. They should show exemplary behaviour with their head held high, providing a shining example of leadership, trust, courtesy, love and goodness.
- 5. They should receive the visitors, Guests, parents/guardians etc. during the school functions, activities and Inter-School Competitions.
- 6. They should play an active role in organizing Inter-House activities.

26. RESPONSIBILITIES OF HOUSE CAPTAINS AND CLUB CAPTAINS

- 1. They should be regular to school and punctual for their duties- reporting every time five minutes before the scheduled time.
- 2. They should come to school in proper uniform and follow all norms of the school.

- 3. They should check the uniform of the students of the particular class they are responsible for.
- 4. They should carry out their duties with high sense of responsibility and in an unbiased manner.
- 5. They should work in full cooperation with the school authorities and whenever called for an extra duty, they must always extend a helping hand.
- 6. They should deal with all students in a courteous but firm manner.
- 7. They should bring to the notice of the concerned teachers or other higher authorities of any problem, that she is unable to solve, and also any breach of discipline anywhere.
- 8. They should help their own class leaders in maintaining discipline in their own class.
- 9. They should be role models for other students to follow. Their aim should not be to build a fan following by allowing the students to do what they want.

27. RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRANSPORT CAPTAINS

- ❖ To take note that all the children are in the bus, and that they do not board the wrong bus, check and urge them to bring their bus pass every day.
- ❖ To make sure that the students do not push and reserve the place before time but to give them the place and to see to the order and discipline in the bus.
- ❖ To see that no student changes place while the bus is in motion or that no student shouts and tries to distract the bus driver's attention, or runs and walks, or puts her hand outside the bus.
- ❖ To see that no student shows discourtesy and disobedience to the driver and the assistant or to other children.
- ❖ To check that no student destroys bus property, or is rough and rude with other children, especially the small children that they do not keep the bus dirty and that they do not throw the rubbish from the bus to outside.

AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION."


